How should we pray?

- Pray with **humility**

Prayer is a **relationship**, not a **show!**

- Pray with **sincerity**
- Pray to **God** as your **Father**
- Pray with **thanksgiving**
- Pray **unceasingly**

Be Messy in Prayer

- God wants a **relationship** with you, not a **script!**
- In prayer we should **reveal our hearts to God** and **lay ourselves fully before God!**

God knows **you inside and out**, why not just **give fully of yourself freely?**

Is **anything truly too great or too small** for God?

No!

**Give it up to God, God wants it all!**

Leaving it before God
