4) How does having the mind of Christ change our thinking, feeling, and behavior?

One of Redeemer's Core Values: God uses **Spirit-anointed** teaching of God's Word as a \_\_\_\_\_ to change lives.

Spirit-inspired teaching has been changing lives from the **beginning of the church**.

5) In what way(s) can biblical teaching be abused and misused?

In Acts 2, Peter's life has been **transformed** and now he is telling **others**.

The question: "What is going to form and shape my **mind** and the **minds** of our children?"

- ◆ If we drift, our minds will be shaped by **conventional wisdom**.
- ◆ The New Testament calls us to develop the **mind of Christ**.

6) What does it mean to learn in a repentant spirit?

Teaching became absolutely **foundational** for the church.

- ◆ In the Great Commission we are commanded to **teach**. (Mt. 28:19-20)
- ◆ Jesus was a **teacher**.
- ◆ The new-born church **devoted** themselves to the apostle's teaching (Acts 2:42)

The purpose of teaching is to help Christ be **formed** in us.
